

In 2026, we will have a monthly **prayer focus** on a different area of the world (either country or region). This month our prayer focus is on Iran. Iran has been much in the news over the last few weeks, as government forces have sought to crush demonstrations and dissent. The Christian charity Elam supports the persecuted church in Iran and has the following prayer points: for comfort for families mourning lost relatives, and for the residents of Iran to have a sense of hope despite their present suffering; for restored communications with the outside world and economic relief; for just and righteous leadership; for wisdom and courage for the Iranian church. Lent course - starts Wed 25 Feb We will be running a 5-week Lent course on Wednesdays from 7.30-8.45pm in Mary wise room. This Lectio 365 course is based on the experiences of the Desert Fathers and Mothers, the earliest Christian pioneers who sought God in the wilderness. Come to reflect on what 'season' you are currently in, how silence can be helpful, what we can learn from others and how different rhythms can help sustain our lives of faith.
